

## **Tecumseh Recreation Complex and Arena Guidelines**

The facility guidelines are in place to protect the safety of staff and the public. The guidelines provide direction or protocols to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission. Everyone entering the building is responsible to prevent the transmission of COVID-19 and ensure the facility guidelines are followed.

Effective January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022, due to the mandatory 50% capacity, the following restrictions will be enforced at the Tecumseh Recreation Complex and Arena for all ice users.

- 1. Maximum of two (2) parents/guardians will be allowed with each player.
- 2. Children under the age of 12 living in the same household of the player are permitted in addition to the maximum two (2) parents/guardians.
- 3. Masks must be worn at ALL times other that when participating on the ice. This includes in the dressing room.
- 4. Groups will have access to dressing rooms thirty (30) minutes before and after each rental. Please be reminded as per your permit "Attendees who are in dressing room(s) longer than 30 minutes before or after their ice rental will incur additional charges levied at applicable ice rates. Dressing rooms shall be clean, tidy, and properly secured upon vacating."
- 5. Showers will be operational and room capacities are posted outside dressing room doors.
- 6. No food or drink is to be brought into the facility with the exception of closed bottle drinks for participant hydration.
- 7. The enhanced vaccine certificate with QR code is required to enter Tecumseh Arena. Town Staff/Security will be using a Town mobile device with the "Verify Ontario" app to verify all certificates.
  - A form of government issued I.D. is required.
  - All medical exceptions and clinical trial exemptions will require a certificate with a QR Code.

The Town will continue to update our facility guidelines and procedures as required. We appreciate your understanding as we all navigate the ever changing landscape of COVID-19 in our region.
